Exploring the Health Professions<sup>®</sup> is a curriculum package and corresponding teacher workshop, which is designed to engage junior/senior high school students in hands-on, health-care-related procedures by experiencing a variety of skills used by health professionals on the job. Teachers are provided with detailed teaching instructions and additional resources so that connections between the activities and future healthcare career opportunities can be made. The agenda is set up to demonstrate six healthcare career clusters, such as Clinical Laboratory Sciences and Direct Patient Care.

The toolkit, which participants will use in the interactive exercises, is comprised of demonstrative tools used to execute standard procedures that are performed within each of the career clusters, such as blood culturing.

Each participant will be able to take the curriculum activity book, toolkit, posters, CD game and video with them to perform these engaging exercises with their students.
